Unique features of the Course:

A dedicated head and neck surgical oncology training programme is expected to produce well-trained surgical oncologists specialized in the head and neck region. They will coordinate the overall management of head and neck cancer, a major health problem in the Indian subcontinent. In addition to treatment of established patients they will help to initiate community oncology program, with the aim to lower the stage of disease upon diagnosis and initiation of cancer prevention measures. Overall, this training program is expected to improve the care of head and neck cancer in India.

What are the course Objectives ?

- Head and Neck service is an integral part of surgical oncology department which is one of the largest services in this hospital which accounts for one third of the entire hospital's registration.
- The service runs 1 major operating theatre each day and 5-7 minor operating sessions every week. The minor surgical procedures that include scopes, biopsies and laser surgeries.
